

**Smoky Lake and District Chamber

7pm Noel starts the meeting

1- Approval of agenda - Noel adds 4 new items.

2- Acknowledge guests and new members - Everyone introduces themselves, please see attached list of names attending. Their current project is Lemonade Day which I have also included in the above attachment. Its going to teach the children how to do a business plan, June 22, 2019. Hopefully we can fill Smoky Lake streets with Lemonade that day!! Ross also comments that most of the loan requests are coming from Smoky Lake, so that's good news, because our town is growing and expanding. Noel asks Hank- Smoky Lake Mayor - to comment on whats going on in our Town.

Beaver Hill Lamont bulk station is coming, used car dealership by Pappys, Family Vision eye care, PCN April 2019, Promoting the Pitch in week - keep a clean community, 18,000 dollar donation for new recycle bins. 38th year for the Rodeo, No Demo derby this year though. Home Hardware owners from Lamont are going to reopen Macleods building in May 2019. Provincial and Federal Government have a lot of crews in Town working in our area, they are bringing in more business to Town, they love it here a very positive impact. The Town is looking to open up a Continuing care center, if anyone has any ideas to please come and see Hank, suggestions are always welcome. Hank will let us know when the Town public meeting is being held so everyone can attend.

Ross comments that Businesses can approach Community futures to start a new Business, or get help with building and finishing your Business plan. Talk to Penny and Jodie exploring the options about where people can meet and improve their Business. Perry is investing more money into his collision shop with a new paint shop. Richard from the Smoky Lake Forest Nursery talks about the improvements being done to the Nursery. They want to bring in school groups from Nait and the University, lots of changes and things need to be fixed and done, starting with the lights. They want to hire more local people from Smoky Lake as well.


